



Storm TOPSoccer Coordinator Spring 2018

Job Description

Colorado Storm Soccer Association is seeking a coordinator for our TOPSoccer program. TOPSoccer (The Outreach Program for Soccer) is a community-based training and team placement program for young athletes living with disabilities. TOPSoccer is a modified version of the game of soccer, designed to provide opportunities for special needs children ages 5-18. The coordinator will be responsible for implementing all aspects of the program including but not limited to coach recruitment, scheduling team/player buddies and practices, assisting in the recruitment of participants, and acting as the lead coach for all TOPSoccer practices and events. This is a seasonal opportunity including a 6-8 week season.

Areas of Responsibility

- Lead all practices, games, and activities for the program
- Recruit, train, and schedule all volunteer coaches and player buddies
- Create session curriculum plans and distribute/discuss with coaches and buddies prior to each session
- Communicate to families and participants weekly during the season about schedules, events, etc.
- Provide an exciting and fun environment for all participants, volunteers, and staff!
- Other duties as determined

Requirements/Qualifications

- Past experience working with special needs children preferred, but not required
- Knowledge of soccer and/or TOPSoccer program and curriculum preferred, but not required
- Availability evenings
- Enthusiasm for the program and a positive demeanor
- Background check clearance required

Anticipated spring schedule: Friday evenings 5:30-6:30pm, at Gates soccer complex, March 30 – May 11, 2018

Compensation/Benefits

This is a stipend only position. The TOPSoccer Coordinator will receive \$500 per season based on successful implementation of the program. Most time dedicated will be on field however some administrative duties are expected for successful program implementation and communication.
