Code of Conduct

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behavior in the game.

Play your part and observe Storm's respect code of conduct in everything you do.

On and off the field I will:

- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials and spectators
- Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game
- Promote fair play and high standards of behavior
- Always respect the match officials decision
- Never enter the field of play without the referees permission
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language

When working with players I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- Explain exactly what I expect of players and what they expect from me
- Ensure all parents of all players understand these expectations
- Never engage in or tolerate any form of bullying



- Develop mutual trust and respect with every player to build their self-esteem
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behavior and performance
- Ensure all activities I organize are appropriate for the players ability level, age and maturity
- Co-operate fully with others in football for each players best interest

I understand that if I do not follow the code any/all the following actions may be taken by my club:

- Required to meet with the club or league
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Monitored by another club coach
- Required to attend education courses
- Suspended from matches
- Required to leave the club
