This club is supporting the Respect program to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment.

Remember children's soccer is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical, and social skills. Winning is not everything

Play your part and observe the Respect Code at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials decisions
- Remain outside the field of play within the spectators area
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticizing a player for making a mistake-mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behavior



I understand that if I do not follow the Respect Code any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club or league
- Obligated to undertake an education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership revoked
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

In addition:

- The club could impose a fine and/or suspension on the club
